Model A Topics for Discussion:

Being Prepared for touring with your Model A

I always wondered what are the proper set of supplies and tools needed to be kept in the Model A for cruising around town. The MAFCA made a list. What would new members need?

TOOLS

- Jack and handle
- Starting crank
- Tire pump
- Ball peen hammer
- Socket Wrench set 5/16-7/8
- Adjustable wrench, small
- Box wrench 5/8 x 3/4 (generator)
- Box wrench 1/2 x 9/16 (battery)
- Screwdrivers
- Pliers
- Wire cutter/crimper/stripper
- Ignition tools (feeler gauge, file)
- Grease gun
- Flashlight
- Tube patch kit
- Electrical circuit tester
- Distributor shaft wrench
- Tire irons (2)
- Knife, Scout type
- Scissors (for gasket work)
- Emergency flares or flashers
- Spark plug wrench that fits YOUR plugs
- Model A adjustable wrench
- Drift, 5/8" diameter, brass
- Drift, steel
- Socket, main bolts
