I always wondered what are the proper set of supplies and tools needed to be kept in the Model A for cruising around town. The MAFCA made a list. What would new members need?

TOOLS

Jack and handle

Starting crank

Tire pump

Ball peen hammer

Socket Wrench set 5/16-7/8

Adjustable wrench, small

Box wrench 5/8 x 3/4 (generator)

Box wrench 1/2 x 9/16 (battery)

Screwdrivers

Pliers

Wire cutter/crimper/stripper

Ignition tools (feeler gauge, file)

Grease gun

Flashlight

Tube patch kit

Electrical circuit tester

Distributor shaft wrench

Tire irons (2)

Knife, Scout type

Scissors (for gasket work)

Emergency flares or flashers

Spark plug wrench that fits YOUR plugs

Model A adjustable wrench
